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Sample Prescription Format

If the following guidelines did not produce satisfactory results, consider ordering the Willow Curve®

Phase 1: Basic Modalities tried (1 or more):

- o Heat
- o Theracane
- o Stretch
- o Topical Analgesics

Phase 2: If Phase 1 did not treat the condition or eliminate the pain; tried 1 or both:

- o TENS
- o AcuTENS

Phase 3: If Phase 2 did not treat the condition or eliminate the pain; tried 2 of the following:

- o Participating in PT or has failed it in the recent past (6-12 months) for the same condition; may include pool therapy
- o Engaging in therapeutic lifestyle changes such as diet and exercise
- o Practicing CIM (Complementary Integrated Health) treatments to reduce opioid usage
- o Participating in their MHC (Mental Health) sessions
